Key Weekly Objectives

Each week we will highlight key objectives covered in seventh grade during the week.

Literature:

To practice vocabulary, comprehension, interpretation, literary connection, artistic representation, close reading over the course of a fictional text through literature circle

Religion: To understand how the four different gospels present a different yet consistent biography of Jesus Christ and his mission by examining each original audience and purpose behind each gospel narrative.

Math: To identify appropriate customary units; to convert customary units

Science: To explain how the availability of natural resources affects human population growth

Language Arts: I can self and peer review by comparing my writing to a rubric, and revise as needed.

History: I can analyze and synthesize several documents in order to draw conclusions about the death of historical Jesus.

CLASS UPDATES

SUCCESSES: The students produced some very good literature circle job assignments. The students focused and took notes on the four gospels lecture in preparation for their test after break.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH: It is fun to have review games for vocabulary but we can't do it if the students don't take it seriously or if they get too loud. Similarly students are expected to talk turning literature circle meeting sessions but there should never be yelling and more than one student must not speak at a time. There are no side conversations during literature circles.

(Except for the last week before Christmas break when the last meeting will be on Thursday, December 19th) Every student is responsible for the assigned reading and his or her job assignment for each literature circle meeting group. No late assignments will be accepted for these assignments because they are letting their group down if they are not doing their part. The only exception to this is an absence, and then the assignment is due upon the student's return.

Literature circles do NOT take the place of independent reading. Students still need to be reading an independent reading book during SSR, and each week's reader's notebook is based on the independent reading not the literature circle book.
