Key Weekly Objectives



Here we will highlight key objectives that we are targeting in seventh grade during the week.

Literature:

To analyze several poems by Robert Frost and examine his use of natural imagery and make connections to the role nature plays in S.E. Hinton's *The Outsiders*.

Language Arts:

To correctly combine sentences using compound subjects and compound predicates.

Social Studies:

To examine the shift of power from the west to the east in the Roman Empire that occurred with the rise of Constantine.

Science: To identify the chemical compounds found in cells, and to predict whether foods contain starches or lipids; conclude from the tests they perform whether their predictions are correct

CLASS UPDATES

SUCCESSES: The students continue to be very excited an engaged in our study of *The Outsiders*. They can't get enough of this YA classic. I encourage you to talk about the important themes and ideas in this novel including friendship and family and what it mean to belong or be on the outside of society.

OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH: While the students are loving *The Outsiders*, this week I have noticed that many students are not confortable with examining and interpreting a text for themselves. They either want to answer in vague generalities or be spoon-fed the answer instead of using the text to support their interpretations. They are afraid of getting the "wrong" answer. They are uncomfortable non-factual questions. Unlike math or science, in literature there are often many right answers as longs as those answers come from a reading of the text.
