### Key Weekly Objectives

Each week we will highlight key objectives covered in seventh grade during the week.

#### Literature

Independent Reading Objective: To strengthen reading comprehension skills and increase stamina, students will read independently daily and record their progress and dialogue weekly with their teacher through their reader's notebook.

**Vocabulary:** To expand one's vocabulary by learning to use new and challenging grade-level vocabulary.

**Religion:** To review the parts of the mass and the mass responses to more fully participate in the liturgy.

**Math**: To use the order of operations and to use grouping symbols To graph and order integers; to find opposites and absolute values To use models to add integers; to use rules to add integers

**Science**: To begin to examine ecosystems from a macro perspective: based on plate motions, what geographic features are present in different ecosystems?
